# Tri-State Grotto Digs at Crystal Grottoes Caverns

Boonsboro, MD-Tri-State Grotto returned to Crystal Grottoes Caverns to continue their dig in the Tri-State Grotto Passage.



As the group walked into the cave and into the Tri-State Grotto passage, it was noted that there were pools of water in the passageway and the formations were dripping water. That was a big topic during the morning session.

It hadn't had rained for a while. Maybe the creek water was finding its way into the cave. But the formations were dripping. Back and forth it went trying to advance theories for each scenario.


Later we found out that Jerry Downs had pumped water into a sinkhole to see where it came out. He found that it did come out into the Tri-State Grotto passage. He was surprised that it was still wet, as he had pumped the water two weeks ago. Mystery solved.



As the dig started, it was noted that at the end of the passage, instead of running into a wall, there was a slope from the floor heading up. We knew that we had to dig out the slope before we busted through the clay wall to the other side.


In talking to Jerry Downs, Owner of Crystal Grottoes Caverns, he said he would like to wait until next time to bust through. He wanted to get the newspaper and TV down for it.

We spent most of the day digging out the slope and pushing the wall back until there was only about two feet left to reach the other side.



When the slope was dug out and the wall was squared off, the work shifted to the floor. Starting at the headwall, the floor was lowered by a foot. As the wagons came, they stopped at the edge and they were filled. The edge was taken back and the wagons rolled right up to the new edge and were filled again.

While waiting for the clay to be broken loose into hunks, Carol worked on a side passage that was filled with clay. We wanted to take that down so it wouldn't collapse onto the passage. We had another clay bank fall into a passage a few digs back. Today in the same area as the first slide we saw another small one. It wasn't across the passage and we left it for a future time.




At one point a large formation was found imbedded in the clay. It stuck out a foot and a half and was two feet in the clay. Carol was told to take her guarding tools and dig around it. When it was loose, it was pulled out and placed in an empty wagon. Some other large pieces were added and it was pulled out and taken to Jerry Downs. He said later that he was going to have it repositioned in another spot in the cave.

When it was time to break for lunch, Tri-State Grotto found two pots of chili, one with meat and one without. Also there were two large pizzas, sodas and bottled water, which were available all day long.

After lunch Tri-State Grotto returned to the dig. Soon wagons of clay were rolling up to the surface.

While we were digging I heard Carol say," Hi Bat."

I turned to look and she said it flew in, turned around and flew out the way it came. We could track it through the cave by the screams that we could hear as it passed by each tour group.



Todd Zimmerman had taken two broken wagons home with him last dig. He returned with them fixed and brought with him a repair kit in case another one breaks. So far, he has had to fix all four wagons. After Tri-State Grotto stopped digging we took a tour of Crystal Grottoes Caverns, both above and below the ground.

The pavilion has been rebuilt with a nice stone wall added. A grill will be going in next to it. We checked out the new stairs and porch. The grills are attached to the stone wall and the steps are going through solid rock.

In the cave we did a reverse tour so we wouldn't get in the way of the paid tours.

In the Blanket Room the stone wall was finished around the Blankets. In the Lake Room a stone wall

replaced the plastic chain by the lake. This will make it safer.



In the lake we saw baby salamanders. It was loaded with them.

Our volunteers were: Russell Linton, John DiCarlo, Bob Bennett, Todd Zimmerman, Carol Tiderman, Joe Clemens and Eric Ropp.

We had 49 volunteer hours. We took out 44 wagonloads that equaled to 176 drywall buckets. The donated cost of our project this day is \$1,050.00.

Tri-State Grotto will be back again to push through the final wall.


