# Happy Birthday!



TSG Meeting (11 people in attendance) November 13, 2019

John called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Elysia gave the Treasurer's Report. Doc reported the minutes of last month's meeting October 9, 2019.

<u>Committee Reports</u>: Doc will be receiving a tent pole from Bob in order to use the size to cut new ones.

Same status as last report concerning climbing gear which is in fine condition.

Doc now has all the helmets for cleaning and repair.

Adam will be using a dozen helmets for his upcoming trip to Jones Quarry Cave.

Access to make changes to the TSG website is in a forbidden status. Ashby Haines can set up a server to post information into. At present TSG has only one out of date website.

TSG inventory list begins January 2020. Doc will be taking inventory.

John DiCarlo now has ear protection and safety glasses added to the hammer drill including a pointed bit and a shovel bit.

Tom Griffin has two three hundred-foot rolls of rope equaling six hundred feet for club use. There is a new drive after the loss of the original. The new drive is now held by Ashby Haines.

Old Business: Wednesday night caving trip to Donaldson Cave went well with an few cavers traversing the loop. The only water was found in a hole in a back passage dug out a few years ago for measure. John commented that after finding a long-tailed salamander, Donaldson Cave is a healthy cave. There is a new lock on the gate. In order to visit the cave, the troop leader must provide the following: the total of the group, leader's name, leader's NSS#, leader's address, leader's cell phone#, leader's email address, name of group, date of trip and time of the trip. The lock will be checked after each visit.

There was an enquiry as to the ownership of Donaldson and Jones Quarry Caves. Donaldson is owned by the West Virginia Cave Conservancy, while Jones Quarry Cave is privately owned. A discussion of Jones Quarry Cave concerning the key, volunteers work and general connection with the owner followed.

John and Doc inspected the Hollow Hill dig and came to the conclusion that dig should be inspected after the winter. Doc reported that there may still be viable cave yet to be discovered. The discussion of generating hard copy of the DDD was finalized and dismissed.

The Christmas party will be held on December 7 at the Bedington Ruritan Club building located at 3947 Williamsport Pike, Martinsburg, WV 25404, starting at six. There may be a visit from a cave owner or two. Food, libation and fellowship will be featured.

<u>New Business:</u> Wednesday, November 20 there will be a climbing class at Rumsey.

Wednesday night caving conflicts with Thanksgiving Day this year. The event will be held on Saturday, November 30. Meet in Jones Quarry Cave parking area at eleven. Adam Haines is hosting the trip.

A poll was taken on who took their Moms caving. Approximately one hundred and ten people attended the Banquet held in Lewisburg last month. Afterwards there were cave visits for those who traveled home via the interstates.

Klines Gap Cave in Great County was mentioned and considered being visited.

Terry visited Memorial Cave on his 70th birthday. The dig at unnamed cave continues with Front Royal grotto.

Sinks of Gandy property is for sale for twentyeight million dollars. The property has approximately 800 acres.

There is no new news concerning Mystic Cave.

No need to fall into the water it was still very muddy. Good thing there was no current since out boat had no oars after the first stop. Lol. Afterwards we headed to an Italian restaurant for good food and lots of laughs including the waitress with a since of humor. About 11 cavers in all.

### 11/17/19 ---- Whitings Neck Cave, Berkeley Co,

<u>WV</u> --- Ryan Mauer, Hope Brooks, another caver? and myself (Tom Griffin) met at Whitings Neck to complete the survey information. 2 areas needed done. The back past the rabbit hole and the passage to the left of the drop. After about 5 hours the survey was complete.



After passing many horizontal hand lines, sketchy slopes, ladder bridge, spiral staircase and about a 150-foot climb using a hand line we made it out in the middle of an uncovered greenhouse. The other Penn cavers were great to hang out with. Afterwards we headed to a pizza joint where a 36-inch pizza fed 9 hungry cavers.

12/6/19 -- Whitings Neck Cave, Berkeley Co, WV --I (Tom Griffin) met 3 other climbers from DC. They had a few days to travel around. I met them at Whitings Neck. They were just getting to set the drop. 2 had never caved before. Lliddia, Sylvain and Samuel. For never caving before they never hesitated to hit the small leads or climb to the top of the canyon, down the rabbit hole to the very back with all the claymations. They did bring their dynamic 10.2 mm 77-meter rope. Nothing but fun climbing a dynamic rope. Afterwards we hit Indian River which they got to learn a bit about the bats, good picture opportunity. Then we headed to Donaldson's. Their energy seemed endless. If I could have found another cave, I'm sure they would have done that also. For me very tiring day, still a great day with high energy people.
